

## **Sola Community Peace Center Internship for Curriculum and Training**

This internship is a program of Sola Community Peace Center for 25 hrs/wk for a college student for 2 months during summer – preferably June and July but could be adjusted according to intern’s availability. It engages qualified young adults in developing peacemaking curriculae, helping implement it, and training the trainers who will teach the curriculum. The internship will be involved with programs for peace with justice with economically disadvantaged young people in the communities around USC. The intern will work with the Executive Director to create the curriculum for Peace Camp and develop the Sola Community Peace Center Trainers Program. The intern will work with the Executive Director to oversee and facilitate the development of Sola Community Peace Center Trainers. The intern must be able to take initiative and work independently.

### **Duties**

- \* Meet once a week with peace center director or designated staff
- \* Work with Executive Director and Peace Camp staff to develop curriculum for this summer’s peace camp
- \* Be trained as a trainer in peacemaking curriculum
- \* Work with Executive Director to train other trainers
- \* Help develop curriculum manual and training materials
- \* Help implement curriculum in Peace Camp
- \* Develop and host at least one experiential Curriculum and Training skill-building workshop for Peace Camp youth interns and summer staff

### **Required Qualifications:**

- \* 18 years of age or older and graduation from high school or equivalent
- \* Interest and experience with curriculum development
- \* Interest in youth and peace with justice
- \* Commitment to nonviolence
- \* Excellent written and verbal communication skills
- \* Excellent organizational and interpersonal skills
- \* Ability to pass background check
